

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy applies to Stonington Insurance Company and Stonington Lloyds Insurance Company.

Commitment to Privacy

This Privacy Policy is specifically designed for the protection of Consumers' nonpublic personal information, as defined by state and federal law. Protecting the privacy of Consumers' nonpublic personal information is important to us. We restrict access to Consumer's nonpublic personal information to only those employees who need to know that information in order for us to provide insurance and conduct our business. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to ensure the privacy of Consumer's nonpublic personal information.

Information we Collect

We collect nonpublic personal information in a number of ways:

- From you (such as applications or other forms)
- From your transactions with us (such as payment history, policy coverage, or claim documentation)
- From consumer reporting agencies (such as motor vehicle records or credit report information)

We use information collected to underwrite policies, process claims, and generally conduct the business of insurance.

Disclosure of Information

We may share a Consumer's nonpublic personal information among affiliate companies in order to better serve you and assist in the conduct of our business. If you prefer that your nonpublic personal information not be shared with such affiliates, you can call us toll free at 866-255-4920 to obtain an "opt-out" form. This opt-out choice is applicable only to the sharing of Consumer's nonpublic personal information among affiliate companies.

We may disclose a Consumer's nonpublic personal information as required or permitted by law to non-affiliated third parties such as agents, third party claim administrators, and other service providers who assist us in servicing your policies and claims. Additionally, we may disclose a Consumer's nonpublic personal information as required or permitted by law to non-affiliated third parties such as consumer reporting agencies for consumer reporting purposes, or law enforcement agencies or other third parties who prevent or investigate suspected fraud.

We do not sell Consumer information.

Modification of Privacy Policy

We retain the right to change, supplement, or otherwise modify our Privacy Policy. If we make modifications to our Privacy Policy, we will provide you with our current Privacy Policy.
