

THIS ENDORSEMENT CHANGES YOUR POLICY. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY.

POLLUTION EXCLUSION ENDORSEMENT

This policy provides no coverage for any loss caused by or resulting from "Pollutants" as defined here.

This exclusion applies to all coverage Parts of Section I – Property Coverages ,

This exclusion applies to all parts of Section II – Liability Coverages.

There is no duty to indemnify or defend any **Insured** who seeks coverage for a claim, action, suit or demand alleging **Bodily Injury, Property Damage** or Medical Payments caused by or contributed to by reason of any actions, neglect or other omission by any Insured or by others at the direction of, or under the custody or control of any **Insured**, and relating to any claim arising out of, or alleged to arise out of any use, maintenance or management of the **Insured Location and arising from any "Pollutants" as defined here.** This exclusion also includes any other location owned, managed, maintained or under the care, custody or control

There is no coverage for either actual or threatened loss or damage. There is no coverage for discharge, escape, or release of "pollutants".

The term "Pollutants" includes any form of irritant or contaminant. It includes, but is not limited to vapor, soot, fumes, acids, alkalis, or chemicals. Examples of "Pollutants" include oil, asbestos, insecticides, herbicides, lead and/or waste containing these items.

We will not pay or defend any claim or suit for Bodily Injury or Property Damage caused by or resulting from pollution to or from property you have sold. This includes the land and any structures.

The following are covered and not subject to this Endorsement.

1. Sudden and accidental discharge of smoke, soot, or other "Pollutants" cause by fire or explosion.
2. Damage or injury resulting from a sudden and accidental discharge, leakage or seepage from within any plumbing, air conditioning, heating or ventilating system at any Insured Location.

Unless otherwise changed or deleted by this Endorsement, all other policy terms and provisions will apply.
